

SP Group generates record S\$1.1m for its annual charity drive

SP Group delivered over 2,800 Power Packs – comprising food items, vitamins and antigen rapid test kits, among others – on Thursday (Jan 20) to low-income families around the island ahead of the Chinese New Year festive season.

The company aims to donate a record 10,000 Power Packs by end of this year to the same number of families.

The annual SP Power Packs charity drive is into its ninth year and the company has committed over S\$1.1 million to the items which were prepared and distributed by SP's staff volunteers.
